The first part of this workshop is asynchronous and must be completed before we meet for the live session on July 7. To get started:

3. Complete the brief two-part assignment beginning with of a short 7-minute video, collaboratively annotating the video and an article with other participants, as explained in the video. The workshop will be tailored to the points arising from your annotations.
